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LPA IN BRIEF

The Light to progress academy (LPA) is a Christian refugees based institution with no political affiliation. LPA intends to promote children right to access education and support the empowerment, self-reliance and hope restoration of vulnerable individuals such as Persons with special needs (PSN) and persons with disability (PWD) living in Nakivale Refugee Camp in starting over and enjoying the gift of life from God the creator through education.

PREAMBLE

Whereas it has been deemed necessary to create a nursery and primary school for the purpose of eradicating illiteracy and provide quality education and better learning chain for children refugees and host community in Uganda/ Nakivale Refugee Settlement. Realizing the lack of access to education for many African children, and poor education standard that children refugee have faced in past years.

Conscious of the immense need of high quality education standards in the place. This school shall carry out activities such early childhood development, primary school education, award of scholarships to vulnerable children, and community awareness toward promotion of quality education.

Aware of the fact that quit a number of children are raised in poor families, others are orphans, victims of social conflicts and/or unaccompanied, they are at risk and vulnerable of many terrible matters among which; child trafficking, street children, child in sex business, defilement, rapes, robbery etc. are dangerous for both present and future generations.

Believing that education would bring durable solution to these problems and impact the world in general and Africa in particular as it is said "education is the most powerful weapon that can

change the World." So this institution is to spark the community not only socially but also spiritually, intellectually, morally and economically.

Reaffirming in words and action that the prime purpose of children development is the uplift and promotion of their welfare and right to education without discrimination of all kind. Thus all children should access education equally.

Now therefore in pursuance of the said purpose and aspirations, we the LPA officials hereof open doors to volunteers, donors, governmental and non governmental agencies, national and international organizations, development partners as well as stakeholders to work hand in hand with us to support education of African children refugees.
